



## Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing Family Camp



### *What to Bring*

- Sleeping Bag or Bedding (you may want to bring a sheet to cover the mattress)
- Pillow
- Boots, Tennis Shoes
- Towel and Toiletries
- Flashlight and Batteries
- Rain Jacket
- Hat and Sunscreen
- Water Bottles and Snacks
- Camera
- All-weather Clothes (Weather conditions are unpredictable so bring warm and cold weather clothing)
- Swim Suit (there's a *possible* chance that the pool will be ready and warm enough to swim in)
- Cochlear Implant charger, extra hearing aid batteries, etc.
- Baseball mitts, balls, etc.

### **YMCA Rules**

- In order to ensure both a fun a safe time at Family Camp, the YMCA has asked us to observe the following rules:
- All YMCA activities areas are off-limits unless supervised by trained YMCA Camping Services staff member. These activities include but are not limited to Archery, Boating, the Climbing Tower, Riflery, and the Pool.
- Pets are not allowed at camp (with the exception of service dogs).
- No swimming in Lake Jessop.
- Alcohol is not permitted on camp property.
- Please refrain from parking or unloading on any roads because they are designated fire roads. The speed limit in camp is 10 m.p.h.
- Smoking is only permitted on paved areas (camp roads and parking area). Due to the threat of fire danger, smoking is not permitted in any buildings or in the forest.
